

Spectral Sciences, Inc. Receives 2009 Cogswell Outstanding Industrial Security Achievement Award

June 17th, 2009 – Spectral Sciences, Inc. (SSI) is proud to announce that the Department of Defense Security Service (DSS) has awarded SSI the highest honor it can present to a government contractor, the 2009 James S. Cogswell Outstanding Industrial Security Achievement Award.

Spectral Sciences, Inc. was one of only 14 recipients of the 2009 award out of over 12,500 eligible defense contractors. To be considered for the prestigious honor, nominees must go through a rigorous selection process that requires extraordinary security practices on behalf of management and the facility workforce.

Cogswell Award nominees must have a minimum of two consecutive superior industrial security review ratings, be vetted by more than 20 government agencies, show a sustained degree of excellence and innovation in security program management, and have a longstanding record of outstanding security practices based on standards set by the National Industrial Security Program.

The Cogswell Award, established in 1966, is named in honor of the late Air Force Col. James S. Cogswell, who was the first chief of the unified office of Industrial Security.
